**DNA: Tests, Tools and Tales** will offer two tracks — one for beginners and one for more experienced users of genealogical genetic testing. The beginners will learn about the basics of genetic genealogy, including what tests are available and how to work with and understand their DNA test results, and will have the opportunity to attend a mentoring session. Intermediate and advanced users of DNA testing will learn about GedMatch and other tools for interpreting and using genetic data. Early registration fees are \$45 for JGSI members, \$50 for non-members and \$25 for students. After May 20, the fees are \$10 higher. THROUGH OCTOBER**
