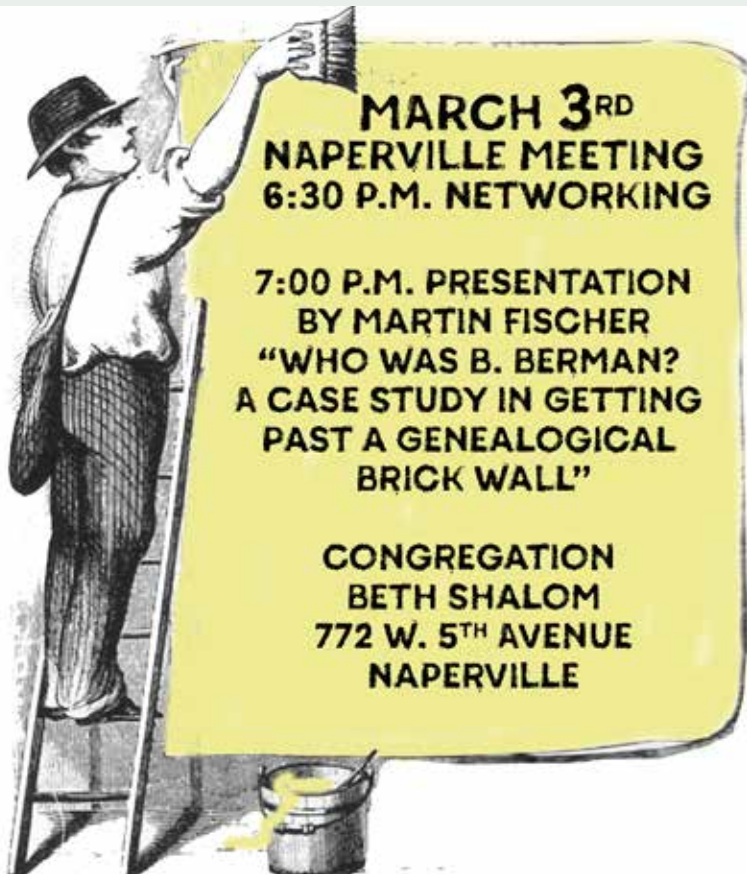
12:30 p.m. Research, Internet, and genealogical help from JGSI volunteers.

Tips for Saving and Sharing Family History in Written Form.”



In his presentation, Marty will discuss the many different forms genealogical writing can take, describe the process and explain how to organize a piece of family history writing. He will offer tips on writing problems to avoid and suggest possible topics family historians may want to write about. His presentation will include a brief introduction to the pre-writing techniques of outlining, mind-mapping and stream-of-consciousness rough drafting. He will also explain the value of focusing on a topic by creating a thesis statement and share a few examples from his own family history.
