There was a congregation and a synagogue at 5633 S. Michigan Ave. sometime between 1908 and 1928. The building still stands, and has been a church since 1928.

The name does not appear on the building. Does anyone know the name of that congregation?

The usual sources such as Gutstein, Meites or the Synagogues of Chicago do not yield any information.

As a reminder about the area, known as Washington Park, three blocks south of the mystery congregation, on 59th and Michigan, was Anshe Dorum, South Side Hebrew. Three blocks north, at 53rd and Michigan, was Temple Israel.

I do not have any specific information regarding ownership of the building the Coppin congregation now occupies. The property was, indeed, built and occupied by a Jewish congregation. It was purchased by Coppin in 1928. Our records relating to the acquisition of the property have been lost. The only information comes from some very old members. They affirm the congregation moved from this building and joined with another congregation to build a place of worship in Hyde Park. It is believed they became the KAM Isaiah Israel Congregation.

A title search might reveal the information you seek.

This is not much to go on but may lead your current research in the right direction.
